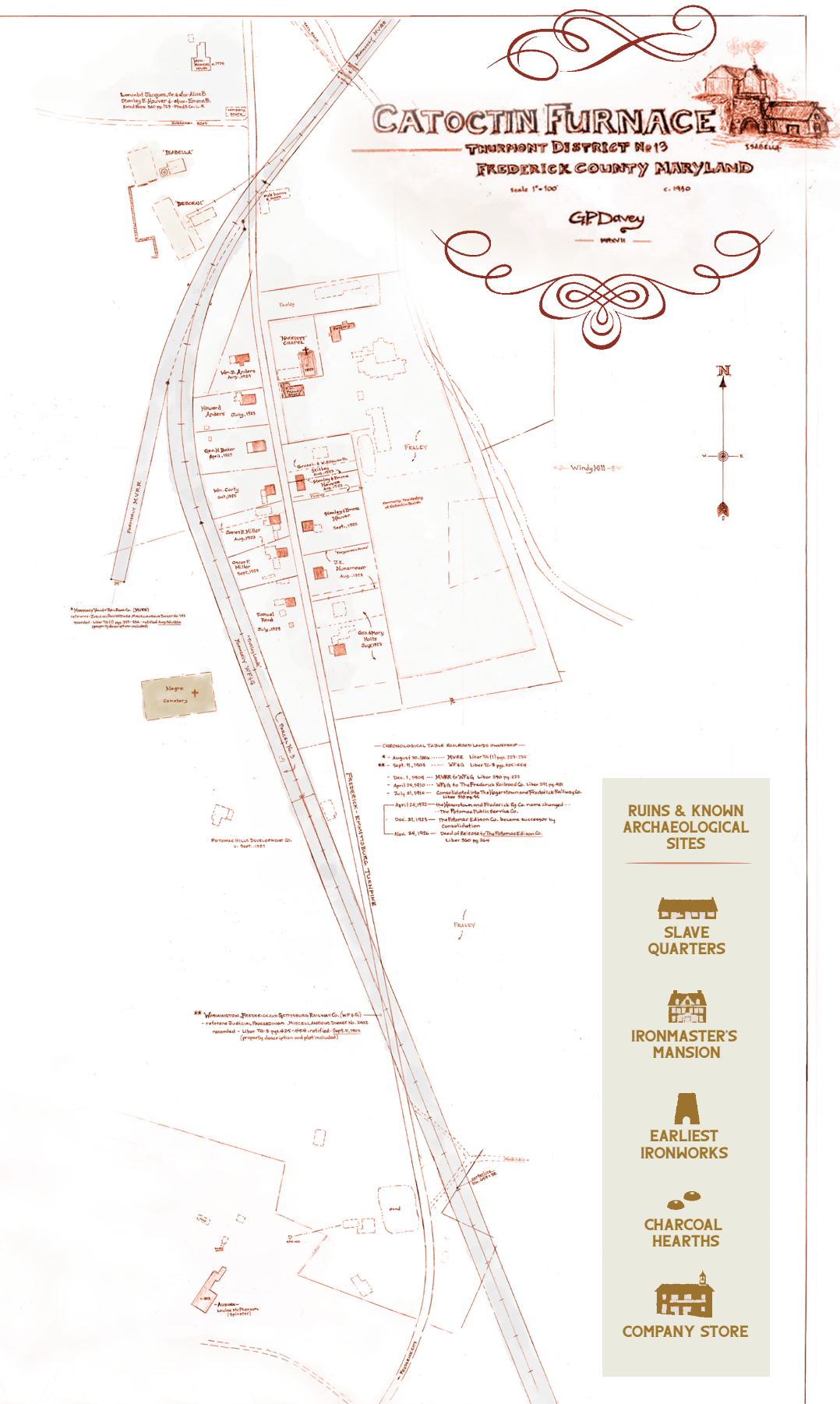

- ** - Sept. 11, 1888 - MARY, Liber 76 p. 421-424
- Dec. 1, 1890 - MARY to W.F. Fraley, Liber 76 p. 227
- April 14, 1891 - W.F. Fraley to The Potomac Railroad Co., Liber 76 p. 421
- July 21, 1894 - Consolidated into The Allegany and Potomac Railroad Co., Liber 76 p. 421
- April 14, 1922 - The Potomac Railroad Co. and Potomac R.R. Co. name changed to The Potomac Electric Power Co.
- Dec. 31, 1923 - The Potomac Electric Power Co. became successor by Consolidation
- Nov. 24, 1925 - Deed of Release by The Potomac Electric Power Co., Liber 76 p. 244
