VIII f Dorcus Johnson - b. Calvert Co. Md. Oct. 7, 1734, d. Dec. 8, 1809. Buried at Steamshury near Urbana, Frederick Co. Md. Married Col. Josiah Clapham of Loudon Co., Virginia. Col. Clapham was associated with the Johnsons in the Patowmac Iron Furnace opposite Point of Rocks, Md. No issue.

VIII g James Johnson - b. Calvert County, Md. Sept. 30, 1736, d. Dec. 3, 1809. Married Sept 1770 to Margaret (Peggy) Skinner of Talbot Co, Md. b. 1749 d. Sept. 3, 1813. His will probated Jan. 27, 1810. He managed the Old Flat Frederick Furnace, Washington Co. Md. in 1773. In 1774, he managed Patowmac Furnace in Frederick Co. Md. After marriage the Iron Works in Loudon Co. Virginia. He was a Major in the Maryland Troops from April 1777 to May 15, 1777 and was then Colonel in the "Flying Camp" & was his brother Thomas.

IXa James Johnson, Jr. - b. Fort Frederick Furnace Md. May 26, 1771, d. July 22, 1850. Married Ann Matthews Richards of Baltimore, Md. A. Oct. 5, 1785, d. Nov. 18, 1840. He conducted a bakery in his father's farm on St. Leonard's Creek "Brookhatch" during the winter of 1812 and furnished supplies to Commodore Joshua Barney. He was living in a small house near the creek, since the main house had burned. Genealogist.
